COLOUR Zeverre

Below are fill weights for Colour de Verre designs. For each design there is the option of two fill weights. The first, labeled "Weight," is for a high temperature firing during which the glass particles complete melt and become very liquid. This causes the casting's edges to round and pull away from the mold's edges. The second, labeled "Thin Fire," is for a lower temperature firing during which the frit particles simply melt together.
